[Electronic Proposal Development \(ePD\)](#) is a fully automated system that allows PIs and departments to electronically prepare and submit sponsored research proposals to central review offices and ultimately to our sponsors. The implementation of ePD will lead to the automation of the entire proposal preparation, review and submittal process and replace the current manual paper-based process. Highlights of ePD include:

- Smart Form Questionnaires (replaces and enhances the RES)
- Electronic Routing and approval of proposal documents
- Eliminates Paper Forms (RES, PI Assurance, etc)
- Storage repository for all documents and communication
- Automated Notifications
- Data Validation from campus source systems
- Field auto-population
- Real-time visibility of proposal status
- Concurrent proposal processing
- System to System submission (eg. grants.gov)
